Location

Gifu Prefecture's Ibi Senior High School is located in Ibigawa Town, which is just north of Ogaki City and close to Shiga and Fukui prefectures. In the middle of town, flows the Ibi River.

History

Ibi High School was established in 1919 and a memorial building was built in 2009 celebrating the 90th anniversary of its foundation. More than 18,000 people have graduated and been active throughout the country. From 2004, the school has taken a new step forward by being a feeder school for students who wish to apply from Ibigawa Junior High School and Hokuwa Junior High School. In doing so, we have taken an integrated approach with these junior high schools by having faculty exchanges with them.

Facilities

Our campus consists of two main buildings with four floors and two gymnasiums. The large gymnasium is used for sports and club activities such as basketball, badminton, volleyball, and drama club. The smaller gymnasium is used for fencing. There is also a swimming pool, tennis courts, and a large playing field for soccer, baseball, and track and field.
