General Course



Students in the General Course take classes following junior high fundamental subjects, such as Japanese, social science, mathematics, general science, physical education, art, home economics, information technology, and English. We provide extra classes on Tuesdays and advanced classes on Saturdays for university entrance examination preparation.

Integrated Course

The Integrated Course combines the best elements of the general and vocational courses. In the second year the curriculum is divided into three separate courses—language, tourism, and nursing. Students will choose depending on his or her personal interest and desired career.

Language Course



Students acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to communicate effectively in both Japanese and English in order to contribute to the social evolution of Japan. We recommend this course to students who are interested in foreign cultures and languages. Students can take classes such as Different Culture Understanding, Practical English, and Modern English.

Tourism Course



Students acquire the knowledge and skills of local tourism industries to contribute toward regional revitalization. We recommend this course to students who are interested in tourism in Gero or Hotel Management. Students can take classes such as Business Tourism, Regional History, Hotel Manners & Management, and Geography.

Nursing Course



Students acquire knowledge and skills within the fields of health care, human welfare, and nursing, particularly for the elderly and people with disabilities. The goal is to contribute to a society in which every person stays healthy and lives a safe and comfortable life. We recommend this course to students who are interested in nursing and/or welfare work. Students can take classes such as Beginners' Caring, Beginners' Social Welfare, Nutrition, Home Care, and Welfare.



This course is recommended for students interested in professional accounting, such as certified public accountants or licensed tax accountants. Students have the opportunity to take many qualification tests. Students can also enter universities to effectively utilize their qualifications.

Marketing & Information Technology Course



This course is recommended for students who desire a profession in information technology such as a computer programming, systems engineering, or overseeing information systems for companies. Students have a chance to enter universities, especially the faculty of information, to effectively utilize their qualifications
