Education Policy

- ① To have students acquire basic academic skills, and foster their attitudes and willingness toward proactive learning.
- ② To have students consider how they ought to be and ought to live so that they can make efforts to self-actualize.
- ③ To promote both mental and physical health and strength.
- ④ To enhance students personalities and creativity, and foster their abilities to express themselves and to act.
- ⑤ To deepen students' understanding of society and foster the ability to judge properly.
- ⑥ To cultivate students' minds to appreciate nature, tradition and culture, and foster kindness to others. Also, to nurture their spirit of social service and create desirable views on a career.

Course Introductions

General Course~Making use of small classes~

We divide the general course into two classes so that we can teach in small classes. We aim to have students acquire decent academic skills through three-years of careful and constant instruction.

Welfare Course~Aiming to become certified care workers~

This is the only course in Tono and Hida school districts through which students can acquire a national certification, "Certified Care Worker".

After graduation, some students get jobs at special elderly nursing homes and facilities for the disabled. Also, others go on to universities and colleges in order to get more technical certifications such as certified social workers, psychiatric social workers, physical therapists, occupational therapists and nursery teachers.

Home Economics Course~Aiming to be professionals~

In this course, students can acquire the professional knowledge and skills related to home and human life and culture (home economics) such as fashion, food and nursing. Also, we aim to have them foster creativity and kindness to others.

After graduation, some find jobs mainly at local companies. Others go on to universities and colleges specializing in clothing, food, housing and nursing.
