■ First of all, I had a good time in this program.

Especially PUT class was really fun. I felt that the class system with 1 teacher and 4 students is pretty good because there are a lot of time to apply English I've learned. Actually I could talk a lot with friends who are interested in foreign languages. I think this is the best point of going university of foreign studies. I know it could be difficult to do it in our daily English classes, but making groups of 4 or 5 people is going to make our skills better because there may have more chances to talk in English. And talking in PUT was also really natural and I could enjoy myself more than before. But it is sometimes hard for us (actually I also didn't do well in PUT at first). However, if we have had experience of reaction or questions that follow conversation, we can have more natural conversation. I learned it in PUT and I think we can adopt this system.

This program also gave me a chance to think about my path. I have many things that I want to do and I haven't decided which university to go, but I could listen to stories of students there and know that there are many ways to study what I like.

■It was pleasure to go and look around the campus because there are a lot of native speakers who I think want to learn Japanese language. I felt as if I'd been a foreign university. That should also be expected for being foreign people like British, American, Australian, and someone having lived in Philippine and so on.

I have three things to tell you about my best impression on this study tour.

First of all, I considered "PUT" which has the system that spares time with the aim of being able to communicate with someone at ease to use words we have never used. We talked one another for 90 minutes, and this was the best time I've ever experienced in my school life.
